(S) (Satisfactory) is given upon successful completion of a non-credit course and (U) (Unsatisfactory) upon unsuccessful performance in the same.(S) may be assigned to transfer courses. (P) (Progressing) is given upon successful performance in a non-credit course (The "Progressing" grade is not applicable for undergraduate students). (EX) (Exempt) indicates exemption by Departmental examination in courses identified by the Institute's Senate. (NI) (Not Included) is assigned for a course taken on condition that it is not included in the CGPA. (NA) (No Attendance) is given upon failure to attend classes or complete practical or applied components of a course. (NA) configures in CGPA as (FF). (W) (Withdrawn) is given for withdrawal from a course after the closing of the add-drop period and within the first ten weeks of commencement of the semester upon advisor's recommendation and lecturer's permission (The "Withdrawn" grade is not applicable for graduate students).

**GPA** (Grade Point Average), **CGPA** (Cumulative Grade Point Average) A student's academic standing is calculated in terms of GPA and CGPA which the Registrar posts at the conclusion of each semester. The total credit points for a course are obtained by multiplying the coefficient of the final grade by the credit hours. GPA for any given semester is obtained by dividing total credit points earned in a semester by total credit hours. CGPA is calculated on the basis of all the courses a student has taken since commencement of studies for the indicated degree.

**Conditions for award of Bachelor's Diploma**

CGPA not under 2.00, successful completion of all courses required for graduation. Students whose CGPA is between 3.00 and 3.49 are listed as Honour graduates while those whose CGPA is between 3.50 and 4.00 are listed as High Honour graduates. Honour or High Honour standing is indicated on the degree certificate.

**Conditions for award of Master's Diploma in Master's with Thesis**

Student must complete minimum required course load specified by the Department in at least four consecutive semesters with a CGPA of at least 3.00; must take thesis examination no later than the end of the sixth semester upon commencing the programme. The minimum course load is 7 courses (at least 21 Institute credits) excepting mandatory non-credit courses.

**In Master's without Thesis**

student must complete minimum required course load specified by the Department in at most six consecutive semesters with a CGPA of at least 3.00; must matriculate in a minimum of 10 courses (at least 30 Institute credits) and complete a graduation project.

**Conditions for award of Doctoral Diploma**

student must complete the required number of courses specified by the Department within at least four consecutive semesters; maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.00; pass a Doctoral Qualifying Examination; prepare a thesis and hold the Dissertation Defence no later than the twelfth semester upon commencing the programme. The minimum course load is 7 courses ( at least 21 Institute credits ) excepting mandatory non-credit courses.

**Conditions for award of Doctoral Diploma without Master Degree**

student must complete the required number of courses specified by the Department within at least six consecutive semesters; maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.00; pass a Doctoral Qualifying Examination; prepare a thesis and hold the Dissertation Defence no later than the eighteenth semester upon commencing the programme. The minimum course load is 14 courses ( at least 42 Institute credits ) excepting mandatory non-credit courses
